

Please note

- **"DAILY FEE"** : is the fee for a single entry and is valid for 24hours
- **"STUDENT"** is herein defined as an individual aged between 18 years to 23 years old from a recognized learning institution with a valid student's identification document. Students on personally arranged holidays will not enjoy concession rates. A minimum of 2 weeks notice is required for authorization of herein quoted concession rates.
- **"CHILDREN"** Persons above three years but below 18 years
 - A corporate pass may be issued to eligible utility providers having installations within KWS managed parks.
 - East African Citizens and Residents will be charged the respective Citizen and Resident rates in all our Parks, upon producing relevant proof of Identification.
- Other Parks and Reserves include the following: Marsabit, Oldonyo Sabuk, Mwea, Ruma, Saiswa Swamp, South Turkana, Mt. Longonot, Kora, Sibilo, Central & South Island, Tana Primate, Nasolot, National Parks and Reserves.

Safaricard

This is a card used at KWS managed parks by its visitors to enable them get access to the National Parks.
Safaricard is used to gain access to Nairobi, Amboseli, Tsavo East, Tsavo West and Aberdare National Parks.
The card is issued and loaded with money at the Point of Issue/ Sale (POI/POS) respectively and deducted at the park entrance Point of Access (POA).

Obtaining Safaricard

The card can be obtained in all KWS Safaricard Point of Issue Point of Sale (POI/POS) offices upon producing proof of identification; National Kenyan Identity card for citizens, valid Passport or Alien certificate/Work permit for residents. The card is available for persons aged 18 years and above, and caters for accompanying children under the age of 18 years. Safari card is issued at a fee of Kshs 1, 000 per card.

Tour Operators can obtain a Safaricard by submitting an application to KWS Safaricard Manager accompanied by copies of the Company Pin, Company Certificate of Incorporation and KATO Certificate if any.

The Point of Issue/ Sale (POI/POS) offices are found in the following National Parks:-Nairobi Park main gate & East gate, Lake Nakuru Park main gate, Tsavo East main gate (Voi), Mombasa KWS offices and Malindi offices. The offices are opened everyday from 6.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.

The POS offices are located at all Safaricard Offices at the following National Parks:-Nairobi Park main gate, East gate, Lake Nakuru Park main gate, Aberdare Hqs, Tsavo East Park main gate (Voi), Tsavo West Park Mitto Andei gate, Amboseli Park Iremito gate, Mombasa KWS Offices and Malindi Marine.

Proof of identification is required before entry into any KWS managed park.
