KCSE Grade C- (minus) or its equivalent with at least a C- in any two of the following subjects: English/Chemistry/Biology/Physical Sciences/Geography or related subjects. Candidates with a certificate from a recognized institution or having at least 3 years working experience in relevant fields and a minimum of a D+/Div IV may be considered after undergoing an evaluation.

Minimum Admission Requirements:

KCSE Grade D+ or its equivalent, and at least a D+ in any two of the following subjects:- English/Geography/ Biology/Chemistry/Physical Sciences or related subjects. Candidates with at least 3 years working experience in relevant fields and a minimum of D- may be considered after undergoing an evaluation.

NB: Tuition Fee is inclusive of Field Training Programmes.
